How to Play a Tiebreaker

•

The player whose turn it is to serve serves one point from the righthand side. The next player whose turn it is to serve serves once from the left-hand side and once from the righthand side. Continue with each player serving once from the left- hand side and once from the righthand side. Change ends after every 6 points.

The winner is first to seven points, providing they are 2 points ahead, ie, 7-5. If the points are 7-6 you must continue until ahead by 2 points, eg. 8-6.
